**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
NO. 03-14 A1
(Amending AO 3-14)**

**IN RE: RE-ASSIGNMENT OF CASES
IN THE CRIMINAL DIVISION OF THE
COUNTY COURT**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 03-14, entered on October 29, 2003, certain procedures were established for the assignment of cases in the Criminal Division of the County Court of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida; and

WHEREAS, the principal criterion in determining the Court location to which a case is to be assigned is the arresting officer's geographical jurisdiction and/or officer's Court District code; and

WHEREAS, the Town Manager for Miami Lakes has requested that Traffic, Misdemeanor, Driving Under the Influence ("DUI") and Boating Under the Influence ("BUI") cases, which emanate within the jurisdiction of Miami Lakes, be heard at the Hialeah Courthouse rather than at the North Dade Justice Center;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida under Rule 2.050 of the Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, Administrative Order No. 3-14 is hereby amended in the following particulars:

1. As of the effective date of this Order, all Traffic, Misdemeanor, Driving Under the Influence ("DUI") and Boating Under the Influence ("BUI") cases, shall be randomly assigned by the Clerk of the Court pursuant to the currently utilized blind filing system, that emanate within the jurisdiction of Miami Lakes, to be heard at the Hialeah Courthouse, rather than at the North Dade Justice Center.
2. Such cases that were assigned to the North Dade Justice Center prior to the effective date of this Order shall continue to be heard at that Court location.

Except as amended herein, all provisions of Administrative Order No. 3-14, remain in full force and effect

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
