**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

**IN RE: DISMISSAL OF AND
AUTHORIZATION TO PURGE THE
2-MILLION SERIES PARKING
CITATIONS**

WHEREAS, according to the Miami-Dade County Parking Violations Bureau (“Bureau”), the 2-million series (“Series”) of parking citations (“Citations”) were distributed to municipalities in between January of 1996 and July of 1997 (see Attachment “A”); and

WHEREAS, the Bureau advised that it is necessary to purge this Series so that the such numbered Series may be re-used and the Citation forms may be retired as these forms are no longer accurate regarding the current violations and fines; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau further advised that few, if any, of the Citations that remain open from the Series are considered recoverable; and

WHEREAS, the Bureau is prepared to purge the numbers after review of same is concluded; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of Court has strongly recommended that the Court dismiss the Citations in the Series due to the extensive aging on those Citations that make them essentially uncollectible (see Attachment “B”);

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The parking citations numbered in the 2-million Series that were distributed to municipalities in between January of 1996 and July of 1997 are, upon completion of the purge from the Parking Violations System, hereby dismissed due to their extensive aging that make them essentially uncollectible.
2. The Miami-Dade County Parking Violations Bureau is hereby authorized to purge the numbers in the Series after review of same is concluded.

This Order shall take effect immediately upon execution and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
