FACILITY FOR NATIONAL ADOPTION

**WHEREAS**, National Adoption Day will be celebrated nationwide on Saturday, November 21, 2009; and

**WHEREAS**, in commemoration of National Adoption Day, the Judges presiding in the Juvenile Division of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida are desirous of conducting adoption proceedings on Friday, November 20, 2009, at the Children's Museum, located at 980 MacArthur Causeway, Miami, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to conduct such proceedings outside of an established court facility, the Children's Museum must be designated as an off-site court facility;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215, Rules of Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The Children's Museum, located at 980 MacArthur Causeway, Miami, Florida, is hereby designated as an off-site court facility for the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, wherein adoption proceedings will be conducted by Judges in the Juvenile Division of the Circuit, for the period covering 9:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. on Friday, November 20, 2009.
2. Notwithstanding the adoption proceedings being conducted at the Children's Museum, the Circuit Court Judges presiding over such proceedings remain vested with all and singular powers conferred by the Constitution and the Laws of the State of Florida upon a Judge of the Circuit Court .
