FROM THE FAMILY DIVISION TO
THE CRIMINAL DIVISION IN THE
ELEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF
FLORIDA**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the current judicial rotation plan for the period commencing January, 2009 Judge David Miller was scheduled to be reassigned from the General Jurisdiction Division to the Family Division in January, 2009 for a three year period; and

WHEREAS, rather than commencing such reassignment to the Family Division, Judge Miller was temporarily reassigned to the Circuit Criminal Division for one year; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that Judge Miller will remain in the Circuit Criminal Division for the duration of this current rotation cycle and will be credited for the time served in the Circuit Criminal Division as if he were originally reassigned thereto;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rules 2.215, of the Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. Judge David Miller is hereby reassigned to the Circuit Criminal Division in the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida.
2. For judicial rotation purposes, such reassignment shall be deemed to have commenced in January, 2009.

This Order shall take effective immediately and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
